### **Essentials:**

#### **Car Travel:**

- Car Organizers, Backseat Organizers, and Trunk Organizers
- Kids Backseat Organizers
- Entertainment Organizer for backseat
- Snack and Play Travel Tray
- CD/DVD visor organizer
- Food storage container
- Diaper Bag/backpack with extra diapers/wipes, and changing pad
- Cooler (either a 12v or standard ice cooler)

#### **Audio Books:**

- Travel Music, CD's, DVD player with movie selection (great for long trips)

#### **Toys & Games:**

- Activity books, educational books/guides, journal, or note pads

#### **Travel Accessories:**

- GPS navigational system (takes the stress out of road trips!)

#### **Safety & Security:**

- First-aid kit (with burn cream, lip balm, diaper rash cream, chewing gum)
- Sun screen
- Extra food, healthy snacks and plenty of water
- Window shades
- Sun glasses
- Aromatherapy – lavender satchel to sooth teething babies
- Hat, long sleeve shirt (to prevent sun burn) and extra change of clothes
- Vehicle Emergency Kit with jumper cables
- Cell Phone for emergencies
